**Loudermilk Family Foundation Pledges \$250,000 Matching Gift for PATH400
Campaign Committee Formed to Raise \$9 Million to Complete Greenway**

ATLANTA -- The Loudermilk Family Foundation has pledged a matching gift of \$250,000 to Livable Buckhead's [capital campaign for PATH400](#). PATH400 donations to Livable Buckhead between now and March 31st will be matched dollar for dollar.

This is the first major gift to the campaign, which is raising the remaining \$9 million to complete construction on PATH400. Livable Buckhead and the project's lead partners, PATH Foundation and the Buckhead Community Improvement District (BCID), have already raised two-thirds of the total \$27 million project cost through partnerships with the City of Atlanta, Georgia Department of Transportation, and several other entities. Funds raised during the capital campaign will pay for construction costs, land acquisition, and some programming for the remainder of the 5.2-mile PATH400 greenway.

To lead the fundraising effort, Livable Buckhead has assembled a capital campaign committee that includes a broad range of community leaders. Campaign co-chairs Tony Conway of [Legendary Events](#) and Robin Loudermilk of [The Loudermilk Companies](#) introduced the committee members at a cocktail reception held at The Estate on Piedmont on November 11th. Councilmember Howard Shook, who worked to establish PATH400 as part of a greenspace initiative after a study showed North Buckhead to be the “lowest parked district in Atlanta,” delivered remarks during a brief program. Also on hand was Councilmember Mary Norwood. Livable Buckhead convened the committee and will lead local fundraising for PATH400.

About PATH400

PATH400 is a 5.2-mile walkable, bikeable greenway being constructed on public land adjacent to GA400 extending from the bank of Peachtree Creek northward toward the northern edge of Atlanta. It is the centerpiece of a broader greenspace plan, the Buckhead Collection, initiated by Atlanta Councilman Howard Shook. Livable Buckhead is spearheading the PATH400 project in partnership with the Buckhead Community Improvement District (Buckhead CID) and the PATH Foundation. Several other agencies and organizations are involved in the development of PATH400, including Georgia Department of Transportation, the City of Atlanta, MARTA, Atlanta Neighborhood Planning Unit B, and Atlanta Public Schools. PATH400 will increase access to community amenities such as arts, historic, and cultural exhibits; neighborhood pocket parks and greenspaces; retail centers; and learning centers.
