



PATH400SM FACT SHEET

PATH400SM:

- Connects a regional network of current/planned trails, paths, and greenways improving mobility and access for the estimated 250,000 people who live, work, and visit Buckhead daily, in addition to PATH400SM users beyond Atlanta's northside.
- Adds a critical layer to the multimodal transportation infrastructure by integrating pedestrian and bike access, to a network heavily focused on road and transit investment.
- Improves access between community and commerce, enhancing the economic vitality of Buckhead.
- Provides a community amenity for exercise and social interaction across neighborhoods and jurisdictions throughout metro Atlanta.
- Provides an experiential education opportunity for families and local students.
- Provides a natural, engaging, accessible venue for art exhibits as well as historic and cultural assets.

PATH400SM improves direct access for:

- **5,133** residents, primarily within North Buckhead, Peachtree Hills, and the Lindbergh community
- **3,000+** students attend schools within a 10-minute walk or bike ride (Sarah Smith Elementary, Garden Hills Elementary, and Atlanta International School)
- **140,000** workers and visitors in Buckhead's commercial core are within a 5-10 minute walk
- **8,175** residents living within a 10-minute walk
- **16,519** residents living within a 5-minute bike ride
- **44,272** residents within 10-minute bike ride

Connectivity:

- PATH400SM is a critical link to a regional network of trails including the BeltLine, Confluence Trail, and planned Peachtree Greenway.
- PATH400SM connects residents to the commercial core, creating opportunities for office workers, residents, and visitors to walk or bike to work, retail centers, schools, entertainment, and restaurants.
- PATH400SM will connect five Buckhead neighborhoods and a number of public and private schools -bringing together families, friends, and community, and providing an experiential learning opportunity for science and ecology study.
- One of Atlanta's oldest cemeteries, the Lowery-Stevens family cemetery, several planned and current art installations, and other cultural landmarks are in proximity of PATH400SM, giving residents and visitors access to local heritage, art, and culture.
- PATH400SM provides the only bikeable and walkable access to residential and retail centers north of Atlanta, as well as the medical centers in the Dunwoody and Sandy Springs area.
