

How to Commute to Buckhead on a Regional Commuter Bus: Xpress, CobbLinc or Gwinnett County Transit



Xpress, CobbLinc and Gwinnett County Transit provide commuter coach service from Park & Rides in 12 counties to MARTA stations in Downtown, Midtown, Lindbergh and Perimeter Center.

As of 2018, there are no direct routes to the Buckhead core.

To commute to Buckhead on a regional bus, commuters receive a free transfer to and from MARTA.




A full month of transit fare requires 20 trips for MARTA and 20 trips on a regional bus.

All fares must be loaded on the same Breeze card in order to receive the free transfer.
